

The Bible Tells Me Of God' s Will For Me

“Wherefore be ye not unwise, but understanding what the will of the Lord is”, Ephesians 5:17

Jesus is both waiting, and willing to install His Will in our lives. The more important fact to consider at this point is ‘Are we - you and I - willing to allow Him to install it?’ ?

Consider the following.

Early in our Lord' s Galilean Ministry, He was approached by a Leper, Matthew 8:2-4. A leper in the days of our Lord, and under the Law of Moses, was required to keep out of public areas because of a contagious skin disease. He was a sick man. He was a man in pain. The view he had of his life was a panoramic view of hopelessness. His wording, as he spoke to Jesus was, “...if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean” .

Many people to day call themselves ‘christians’ . They have a solid church attendance of twice a year - Christmas and Easter. They have a contagious spiritual disease - demonic possession. They are spiritually sick people. They suffer immense spiritual pain from a disease called ‘worry’ . They panoramically view their lifestyle, and only see a wilderness of hopelessness. Their wording is not the same as the lepers. They do not say. “...if thou wilt, thou canst fill me with your Spirit”, but rather, “I suppose I will get out of this mess one day” .

God, through the prophet Isaiah said, “Come now, and let us reason together, saith the Lord: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool” , Isaiah 1:18.

If you have been on drugs... If you have been on alcohol... If you have been or are a prostitute... If you have been disobedient to your earthly, or spiritual parents...If you have doubted the ability or reality of God...Jesus is still willing to touch YOU.

The reason for using the saga of the leper is because of the words he used, "...if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean".

He praised the POWER of Jesus. His wording said, "If you are willing to heal me, I am willing to accept the healing"!

Jesus is willing to heal us physically today. Jesus is willing to save us today. Jesus is willing to forgive us today.

Jesus is willing to heal us spiritually today. Jesus is willing to install His Will in us today. Jesus wants us to share His Love to others. Jesus wants to fill us with His Blessings today, that we will share them with others.

About half way through our Lord's ministry life, Jesus said, "Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest", Matthew 11:28. Jesus is willing to install His Will into your life today, but have you accepted His offer, and opened the door of your heart to let Him enter?

What is God's Will for your life?

Learn to come to Him in prayer,

Learn to come to him for his guidance,

Learn to come to him for the strength to do what He wants you to do.

Jesus is willing to do anything you ask. Many come face to face with two stumbling blocks at this time,

YOU must be willing to come and ask Jesus for it,

YOU must be willing to stretch forth YOUR hand to take it from the Lord's Hand.

Jesus always received an answer from His Father for His Prayers.

Jesus is willing to answer our prayers each and every day.
